TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Each team will consist of 2 bowlers (1 Youth / 1 Adult)
2. This is not a certified USBC tournament.
3. Entry fee will be \$50.00 per team if pre-registered, \$60.00 per team if registered day of tournament.
4. Handicap will be determined on a scale of 85% of 460, based off of the combined averages of each team member. (For example: If Jane has an average of 160 and her teammate, John, has an average of 210, then Jane-John's average will be 370, with a handicap of 76. ($160+210=370$, $460-370=90*0.85=76$).
5. Average Rule:
 - a. The highest 2008/2009 USBC book average of twenty-one (21) or more games will be used
 - b. If no 2008/2009 USBC book average, the highest 2007/2008 USBC book average of twenty-one (21) or more games will be used.
 - c. If no 2007/2008 USBC book average, the highest USBC book average of twenty-one (21) or more games as listed on bowl.com will be used.
 - d. All others will use a 230 average.
6. There will be two divisions based on the age of the Youth bowler. Division 1 will be for all 12 and under Youths. Divisions 2 will be for all 13 and over Youths.
7. Each team will bowl 4 games in Doubles format and Youths will start all games.
8. The combined score for a team will be the sum of the total pin-count from the 4 games bowled and the team's total handicap for 4 games. (So, if Jane bowled scores of 209-228-187-193 and John bowled scores of 215-217-279-164, then there total score will be $1692+(76*4)=1996$).
9. 90% of the prize fund will be returned in Strike Pot payouts, 300 Game payouts and at a 1 to 6 ratio for winners in each division.
10. 10% of the prize fund will be given to the Homestead Lanes Youth Program.
11. In case of ties, the money will be added together and divided equally between the tied teams.
12. Youths will be paid in S.M.A.R.T. scholarship and Adults paid in cash in a 50/50 ratio.
13. Lane assignments will be made in the order entries are received.
14. Bowlers will move to the right 1 pair of lanes after game 2.

NO-TAP STRIKE POTS

1. Four entries into the No-Tap Strike Pots is included with your entry fee.
2. Youths will be vying for 2 Homestead Lanes Tokens good for \$4 towards any bowling, food or beverages at Homestead Lanes.
2. Adults will be vying for \$5 in cash and 1 Homestead Lanes Token good for \$4 towards any bowling, food or beverages at Homestead Lanes.
3. At the conclusion of each game, two Youths names and two Adult names will be drawn for a chance to win that games Strike Pot.
 - a. In order to win the Strike Pot, the bowlers whose names were drawn must bowl a 9-Pin No-Tap (9 pins), **NOT A STRIKE**, on his/her choice of the lanes that are being used for the tournament.
 - b. If a 9-Pin No-Tap is rolled by both bowlers, then the bowlers split the Strike-Pot and the tournament continues with the next game.
 - c. If a 9-Pin No-Tap is rolled by just one bowler, then that bowler wins the Strike-Pot and the tournament continues with the next game.
 - d. If neither bowler rolls a 9-Pin No-Tap, then two more names will be drawn and the process will continue until each Strike Pot is won.

300 GAME SIDE POT

1. Entry into the 300 Game Side Pot is included with your entry fee.
2. If any bowler shoots a 300 game that bowler will receive \$5 and 1 Homestead Lanes Token good for \$4 towards bowling, food or beverages at Homestead Lanes.
3. Juniors will be paid in S.M.A.R.T. scholarship and Adults paid in cash.
4. If no one bowls a 300 game in the tournament the Side Pot money is added back into the prize fund to be distributed to the tournament winners.
